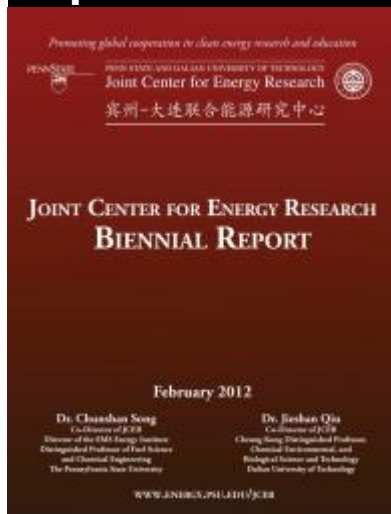




## PSU-DUT Joint Center for Energy Research Releases Report
