Full Membership

This membership level is a fee-based membership that is reserved for small businesses, corporations, and academic institutions that wish to receive the full benefits of the consortium. The membership fee is set by the Consortium Director and may be paid annually.

Full member benefits include:

- Notice of upcoming funding opportunities and meetings;
 - Waiver of meeting registration fees for up to four (4) attendees;
 - Submit projects annually to the consortium for co-funding;
 - Designate one (1) voting representative to the Technical Advisory Committee;
 - Compete for a seat on the SWC Executive Council;
 - Receive technical final reports for years commensurate with membership; and
 - Receive periodic informational publications.
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Affiliate Membership

This membership level is a fee-based membership that is reserved for industrial trade associations and professional societies institutions that wish to receive a limited set of benefits from the consortium. The membership fee is set by the Consortium Director and may be paid annually.

Affiliate member benefits include:

- Notice of upcoming funding opportunities and meeting;
- Waiver of meeting registration fees for up to two (2) attendees;
- Designate one (1) voting representative to the Technical Advisory Committee; and
- Receive technical final reports on projects which they provide co-funding to.

Supporting Membership

This membership level is a non-fee based membership that is reserved for small businesses, corporations, and academic institutions that wish to receive only limited benefits from the consortium. Supporting members may send representatives to Consortium meetings upon payment of a registration fee. The registration fee is set by the Consortium Director.

Supporting member benefits include:

- Notice of upcoming funding opportunities and meeting;
- Submit projects annually to the consortium for co-funding; and
- Receive periodic informational publications.



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
